Step-Wise Accreditation Programme updates

This month the Accreditation Managers worked essentially on document development, review and finalization, including the annual work plan. A process of follow-up is underway for re-engaging some facilities in the AfSBT Step-Wise Accreditation programme.

Tanzanian blood services management teams (34 trainees) underwent the training of trainers, training on blood cold chain, and training on the management of non-conformances (Moshi, Tanzania, 24-29 April 2017).

- ♦ It is the intention of AfSBT to recruit a Programmes Coordinator to coordinate both education and assessment programmes. In the meantime; Dr Tayou Tagny will coordinate Accreditation activities and Dr Tapko will coordinate the Education component of the programmes.
- AfSBT has also recently appointed a Junior Accountant to assist the Finance Director.
- The Communications & Marketing Manager will be retiring after June this year, and AfSBT is currently in the process of recruiting and selecting a Communications Manager as a replacement.


